Takeaway: It is my prayer that you came here today to press restart so God can do something amazing in your life. God wants to do amazing things, but in order for us to do them, we have to look past ourselves and start paying attention to the people around us..

Key Points:

- In life, we don't really lose friends. We just discover who our real friends are.
- 5 Important Ingredients to Successful Friendships:
 - 1) Friends tend to share mutual interests.
 - 2) Friends are available.
 - 3) Friends have a sense of humor.
 - 4) Friends tell the truth when others don't.
 - 5) Friends are listeners.
- If your goal is to be a friend, you will always have a friend.
- As important as friends are, there are things in our lives that only God can fix.
- We may not have everything we want, but we do have enough to still be grateful in our lives.
- You and I may be the only Jesus that someone will see, so if we don't throw out the lifeline, who will?
- There are some things that money just can't buy.
 - Sometimes, to go up, you have to let something go.
 - When people share a common vision and purpose, they will freely put their money where their heart is.
 - United we stand, divided we fall.
- When you really have a relationship with God, the problem is seldom the problem. The real problem is your attitude about the problem.

- Never get so poor that all you have is money.
- When we pray, we have to make requests in Jesus's name so the power of God will be glorified in the son. (John 14:13)
