



## DGM Message Summary: Beyond Forgiveness Pt. 2

### Key Points:

- I Thessalonians 5:33
  - Shalom (peace)- nothing missing, nothing lacking, nothing broken
  - It's God who does the sanctification; we can't do it in our own strength
    - Sanctification- the state of proper functioning
      - A human being is sanctified when he or she lives according to God's purpose for their life
      - The amount we yield ourselves for God's purpose in our life
  - When you discover what you were designed for, life gets much easier
  - Completely (entirely)- leaving no part of us out of this completeness
  - We are made of three components: spirit, soul and body
    - God can keep everyone who wants to be kept
- Hebrews 4:12
  - The Word of God is living and powerful; it impacts the quality of our life (physically and spiritual)
  - God's Word is so on point that it will reveal the deepest part of us (the soul and the spirit)
    - What makes us in the image of God is our spirit
    - Soul and spirit are not easily divided and they are not the same
    - When we were born again, we were changed in our spirit
    - As marrow is encased in the bones, our spirit is encased in our soul
- I Corinthians 6:19
  - Our body is the temple with an outer court, inner court and holies of holies
    - God has to work on your mind in order to release your spirit
  - What we feel often comes out of what we're focused on
- When you don't know the purpose of a thing, abuse is inevitable
  - The problem with random sex is the soul ties that go along with the territory
  - The body is not for sexual immorality
    - Sex was intended to be intimate, and you don't share intimate things with everybody
    - It's not just about sex; it's about trust
- If God's a part of you, he is in every situation in your life (so if you wouldn't do it if God was in the room, you shouldn't be doing it)

- Every sin a man commits is outside of his body, but sexual immorality is sin against his own body
- Your body is the temple of the holy spirit that is within you
  - When you realize that you've lived the way you live not because you are bad but you didn't know better yet....
- In order for us to grow past some of these issues, we must understand our values and who is within you
- You didn't know who you were back then, but God wants to show you how much he loves you!
- Jesus died on the cross to pay the ultimate price for our sins
