### Key Points:

- The Pharisees were Jesus' constant critics.
  - Jesus ate with them.
  - It's hard to influence people you avoid.
- A woman, who was a prostitute, walked in the room where Jesus was located.
  - The woman was a sinner.
  - Others in the room didn't want her there.
- When you discover your true worth it's hard to be around those who don't.
- Jesus had impacted her so much she was willing to be ostracized.
- Jesus was a big deal in those days. It was rude for the people in the house to not honor Him.
- The woman began to wash Jesus' feet and wept with tears of repentance and joy.
  - She washed His feet with her tears.
  - When you know that God accepts you, all else is irrelevant.
  - She was saying everything that needed to be said in that moment.
  - She wiped His feet with her hair.
- One of the Pharisees said she was a sinner.
  - When you define me, you define yourself.
  - Everyone in the room was a sinner except Jesus. The prostitute was the only one who realized it.
  - God cared for the Pharisee just as much as He cared for the prostitute.
  - God loves us all and we all have fallen short.

- Your life was given to you on loan. If God didn't see fit, you wouldn't exist.
  - Do you have insurance from the blood of Jesus?
  - You can't repay God for letting you exist.
- Jesus paid a debt He didn't owe so that we won't owe a debt we couldn't pay.
  - He forgave the men for not being able to repay their debt.
  - When you sin you hurt you, not God.
- Jesus told Simon you didn't give me water for my feet, but she has washed my feet with her tears.
  - She didn't act like God was doing her a favor by coming into their life.
  - People act like God owes them.
  - Many times we forget where we came from.
- Despite our selfishness, recklessness and arrogance He loves you.
