



## DGM Message Summary: Getting Pumped

### Takeaway:

God is calling for a day and night commitment to His Word until it becomes a lifestyle. Once the Word is hidden in your heart, there will be another level of power in you and your ways will be prosperous. When we tap into the strength of God, that strength will become ours and the Lord will give us what we ask for.

### Scriptural References:

- Joshua 1:1
  - No man had accomplished what Moses had accomplished in his lifetime: conquering Egypt (one of the most powerful nations at the time).
  - In spite of Moses' mistakes, He was still a servant of the Lord.
- Joshua 1:2
  - For 40 years, Joshua's job was to serve as Moses' right-hand man.
  - Everyone knew that Moses was dead, yet the Lord had to say it again to Joshua.
  - The Lord called Joshua to get up, wipe the tears from his eyes, and move on.
- Joshua 1:3
  - Joshua and Moses had different anointings.
  - Though the promise came from Heaven, it wasn't activated until hands and feet got involved.
    - Whatever Joshua was bold enough to put his hands and feet on, God was bold enough to give to him.
- Joshua 1:4
  - God gave Joshua a land already filled with people. This was problematic, because the current inhabitants were defiant.
- Joshua 1:5
  - The Lord told Joshua that no man would be able to stand before him **all** the days of his life. This was an anointing for Joshua's entire life!
  - God promised Joshua that He would not leave or forsake him.
- Joshua 1:6
  - Joshua was ordered to divide the land between the inhabitants.
- Joshua 1:7

- God encouraged Joshua to be strong and courageous.
  - In order to do what God called him to do, Joshua would have to tap into God's strength and be very courageous.
- 2 Timothy 1:7
  - God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power, love and self-control.
- Joshua 1:8-9
  - The Lord commanded Joshua to meditate on the Word of God day and night.
  - God also gave Joshua the steps on how to be courageous.

Key Points:

- If you really want to be promoted, stop wanting what others have and focus on what God has for you.
  - Be secure and stay in your own lane.
- We all have different gifts and assignments. We must be careful not to compare our gifts and assignments to those around us.
- We have to get over what's with us in order to get to what's next.
- In this life, some things will not happen until you put your foot down.
  - Pray, then get up, put your foot down, and take what God has given you!
- We should be grateful for all God has done for us thus far, but He is about to release a Joshua anointing in our lives!
- We must shed that passive attitude if we want to move forward and receive all God has for us.
  - If Jesus died for it, we must stop being weak and take a hold of it!
- We will be tested to see if what we proclaim is really there.
  - Love, joy, peace, kindness, meekness, self-control, etc.
- What God has for you may not be on the other side of easy, but the greater the challenge, the greater the reward.
- We may not know during which round our opponent will go down, but we have to find the courage to go into the ring and fight the good fight. We must also have faith that by the grace of God, we will still be standing when it's all said and done.
  - The enemy will come against you, but he will not last!
- God will never put you into a situation He can't get you out of.
- If God has given you a vision, it will always be too big to fulfill in your own strength. If you notice otherwise, it's not of God but of your imagination.
- You may have some of the greatest resources available to you, but if you have the wrong spirit on you, it's not going to end well unless you discern it and call it what it is.
- Oftentimes, satan tries to get us out of the Word because he knows there's power in it.
  - If satan can get into church but get you out of the book, you won't be prosperous.
- At some point, we have to own the words of the Book and they have to resonate in our testimony.
- God wants us to be like a sponge so that when life squeezes us, God's Word comes out of us.
- If you want exceptional results, you will have to go to exceptional lengths.
  - You have to get into the Word until it gets into you. Out of that comes deliverance.
  - Part-timers have a different pay and different benefits than full-timers.
- The doing comes after the saying and meditating.
