Key Points:

- Hezekiah turned to God in his crisis
 - The further the devil tries to pull us back, the more power God releases to propel us forward.
- Babylon was opposed to God, but humanly impressive
 - Sent gifts and wishes for healing
 - Had heard that Hezekiah was sick
 - It's about how we handle criticism, but how we handle blessing
 - Seven days without prayer makes one weak.
- Hezekiah paraded his wealth and buildings to show
 - Treasury
 - Armory
 - There was nothing that he didn't show his guests
- Isaiah the prophet went to King to give him a reality check
 - Confronted Hezekiah
 - Personal accountability is important
- Isaiah gave him a message from the Lord of Hosts
 - The Lord promised judgement on Hezekiah's children
 - God deserves our gratefulness
- Trying to take God's glory is always a mistake and will lead to bad results
 - Listen to the Holy Spirit
 - Listen to accountability partners
