Key Points:

- A recurring dream is often a sign that God is trying to say something.
- You know a dream is from God when it sticks with you.
- God moved Joseph in one day from the prison to the palace.
- God wants to bring sudden reversals into our lives.
- We have to be honest enough to hold onto our values, but humble enough to adapt to our new environment.
- We have to learn to conduct ourselves in the places God will bring us and to communicate without compromising.
- We're not ready for promotion until we're ready to give credit to others and the glory to God.
- A person with knowledge is always at the mercy of a person with insight.
- Have to have a theology that includes both ups and downs.
- Few people really have financial problems.
 - They have management problems.
 - Or they have esteem and self-worth problems.
- How you use your plenty will determine how you flow in lack.
- God seldom stops our famine, but He always prepares us in a good time.
- Webster definition of wisdom – inside information that results in good judgment.
- You don't have to be smart to be wise.
