Message Summary: For us to experience the prosperity of God, we need to commit to working diligently on our jobs as if we were working for God Himself.

Scripture References (NKJV):

- Mark 1:32-39
- Jeremiah 12:5
- Ephesians 6:5

Key Points:

- You'll never get away from work.
- We feel too entitled to do work.
- Jeremiah 12:5 – "If you can't handle the neighborhood dogs, how will you handle the lions when they come?"
- Jesus healed many.
 - Don't put pressure on yourself to be perfect. Jesus healed many, but not all.
 - There is always a remnant of issues.
- Jesus didn't let demons speak. Not all publicity is good.
- V.35 – Jesus only had a few hours of sleep, but still got up to pray.
- We need to show up and do.
- With only a couple hours of sleep and in the cold of the morning, Jesus still showed up.
- Sometimes prayer isn't heard because we haven't left our comfort zone.
- He pressed beyond and went further.
- Paul looked for Him.
 - At times, we have to look for God.
- Sometimes God backs up to see how bad you want this.
- "Let us go somewhere else"
 - If you walk with God, don't build a house where God has only told you to pitch a tent.
- We try to make permanent where God was temporary.
- Will not follow the crowd – Crowd has to follow me.
- Ephesians 6:5 – Bondservants
- On the job, do your job as if God's going to get you if you don't.
- How you do your job is your witness.

- Our work is our ministry.
- If we do it to Him, He'll bless it.
- It's a heart issue. Work from the heart.
- It's not about where you are. It's about your posture.
- Handle it faithfully and you will receive the same reward from the Lord.
- Slave or free, God's got you.
- We need to allow God's grace to work in us.
