DGM Message Summary: The Best Revenge

Takeaway: Success is the best revenge.

Scriptural References (ESV):

- I Samuel 1:1-21
- Judges 17:6

Key Points:

- Never let your problems speak louder than your worship.
 - When we enter His presence with worship, God enters our problems with solutions and power.
- You cannot give to God without God finding a way to give back to you.
- God doesn't love us because of what we can do for him; He loves us just for us.
- Sometimes, what you cannot do is part of God's plan. The thing you are missing is the very thing God intends to use to make you great.
- If someone's trying to bring you down, that's concrete proof that you're up.
- A double portion in one area of your life doesn't always make up for missing pieces in other areas of your life.
- At some point, you have to rise up on the inside and turn to God.
- Prayers are not consecrated until they're dedicated. Never ask God for something you're not willing to give back to Him (or it will become an idol).
- What is the name of the problem in your life? Have you learned God's name in that area of need?
- Pain is one of God's greatest calls to prayer you will ever experience. Don't waste it on feeling sorry for yourself. In your weakness, God gives you supernatural strength. Tears are spiritual currency that shouldn't be wasted and should be exchanged by God for strength.
- Success is the best revenge.
- Sometimes, you have to rise above to be a little bit more than what that person was trying to make of you.
- The answer to your prayer or the season God wants you to step into will require you to give up something and adopt a Christlikeness (sense of dignity) like never before.
