



DGM Message Summary: This One's for You; Bigger & Better

Takeaway: God has a miracle with your name on it this year! Things may not be going your way, but it's only because He has something bigger and better for you. Biblical patience means waiting on God's timing.

Scriptural References:

- John 11:1-44
- Romans 4:17

Key Points:

- In this life, no one will be totally immune to problems, no matter how great of a worshipper you are.
- The key to getting impossible prayers answered is professing Jesus' love in spite of the misfortunes and challenges you are facing.
 - Your response in the midst of your crisis determines whether God will release a Word from Heaven into your situation.
- You can ask for what you want but God may not answer the way you want.
- Sometimes, what you go through is not necessarily about you. It's for the glory of God.
- You sometimes have to face things you never thought God would let happen in order to be promoted.
- If Jesus loves you, why does He seem so far away when you need Him the most?
 - The teacher is always quiet during the test, but when the test is over, the teacher has so much more in store for you.
 - You will not understand the test until it is over and God starts explaining things.
- Any Word from God is just as powerful as a personal visit from Him; God and His Word are one.
- Things that happen in our life are real, but it's not permanent.
- After you've heard from God, you must start agreeing with God and saying what He says.
- Faith is not denying the facts; it's believing despite the facts.
- Sometimes, Jesus has to let you go through things so your faith will grow.
- God is more concerned about growing your faith than your comfort.
- Jesus can conquer any obstacle, even if it's death.
 - If your faith in God is only as big as your immediate problem, your faith is too small.
- Sometimes, the miracle you are trusting God for simply isn't big enough.
- Jesus wants you to know that He is not only the God of the future, but also the God of the present.

- You don't have to wait until the end of your struggle to worship God for what He's going to do in your life.
- It's never too late with God. He always operates in His perfect timing.
- God's silence is just a way to dramatize what He's about to do next.
