



DGM Message Summary: Turning to The Wall

Takeaway: God has the power to heal and turn back the hands of time.

Scriptural References:

- 2 Kings 19:14-19
- 2 Kings 20:1-11
- Jeremiah 18:7
- James 5:16

Key Points:

- When bad news comes, take the issue to the God that can help.
- When you pray, call upon God's history in your life. Remind yourself of what God has done for you in the past.
- Instead of magnifying the problem in your mind, you must magnify God.
- God requires us to believe before He acts.
- Faith is what gets God involved in our affairs.
 - If you don't believe it, you won't receive it.
- Sometimes, bad things happen to good people at the most inopportune times.
- If you know God's heart, you can tap into more than you hear.
 - When you respond to God prayerfully and wholeheartedly, God can turn it around.
- Satan tries hard to limit your praying because he knows that it limits his power in your life.
 - There are so many distractions to keep you from hearing and receiving that one thing that could change everything.
- Imagine what could happen in your neighborhood, family, on your job, in your church if just one righteous person would fervently and effectually pray to God for healing and intervention?
- Being gullible is not the same as having faith. If God is really speaking, He will make it clear and confirm it so we'll know it's really Him speaking.
- You may have a Word but if you don't pray it through, it won't happen.
