



DGM Message Summary: Yesterday Ended Last Night

Message Summary: God knows how to build our faith and knows what circumstances our faith is strong enough to handle. God wants our faith to be so strong that we can see the outcome before it occurs, knowing that the salvation of the Lord will prevail.

Scriptural References:

- Exodus :13:17-21
 - After Pharaoh lets the Israelites go, God intentionally leads them away from the land of the Philistines because they were not ready for battle.
- Exodus 14:1-15
 - God intentionally leads the Israelites into danger in order to build confidence in them for future battles.

Key Points:

- When God led the children of Israel out of Egypt, He didn't lead them through Philistine country though it was shorter because He knew the Israelites were not strong enough for battle.
- God will not lead you into anything you're not ready for. If you're facing it, then it must be because you're ready for it.
- Oftentimes, we think God is slow, but God is not being slow, He is protecting us.
- Spiritual readiness is gradual.
- God loves us enough to ignore our prayers when we're not ready for something.
- Nothing builds our confidence like experiences with God. Consistency produces confidence.
- God wants to build confidence within us so that when trouble comes, He can show Himself strong.
- Some of the people and situations in your life are set up for God to show His glory and do something memorable and too large for you to get the credit.
 - Your enemies are a part of God's plans.
 - The problems in your life are designed for people to remember your name.
 - There are enemies in your life that God can't reach unless He comes through for you.
- As Pharaoh approached, the children of Israel became afraid and began to turn on Moses. Moses spoke to them and gave them three instructions:
 - Don't be afraid. Everything worth having in life is always on the other side of fear. The danger is real, but fear is a choice.

- Stand still. Don't run, don't panic, and don't react. When you run away from the problem, it makes you that much further away from the solution.
 - And see the salvation of the Lord. You can have it if you can see it before you see it.
- "The only thing worse than being blind is having sight but no vision" – Hellen Keller
- Moses told the children of Israel that he needed them to see the salvation of the Lord before it even happens. He needed them to believe.
- If you don't want today to be like yesterday, don't be afraid, don't run, and see the outcome before it happens.
- Believing is seeing God's outcome before you see the outcome.
- If Christ is in you, you don't need anything more than what is in you to win.
 - Whatever God has placed in your hand will be enough.
